Right:

The three distinct "River Reaches" of the site. These three distinct places are a subset of the larger upland-to-lowland landscape type. Each of these reaches has its own distinct feel. Each reach is a subwatershed of the Hyland Creek watershed, which is itself a subwatershed of the Serpentine River watershed.

Far Right:

our proposal locates mediumand low-density housing in the lowland and on the slopes, high-density housing on and near the ridge. As the higher elevations are built up and the lower elevations are preserved, the basic form of the site is emphasized. Civic functions are grouped among the natural and recreational open spaces in the lowest areas of the site.
